DISCOVERY CORON 2023 CSR ACTIVITIES

Adopt a Biik Program - The Adopt a Biik Program has been an ongoing initiative since 2022, where Discovery Coron purchases piglets and awards them to families who wish to adopt them. When the pigs are ready for sale, Discovery Coron buys them back. Fifty percent of the sale proceeds are given to the local families who cared for the pigs, providing them with a means of livelihood.







The Bili Ani Program is an initiative by Discovery Coron that encourages local farmers to plant vegetables and other crops needed for the Firefish Restaurant and Cafeteria. This program aims to provide local farmers with a means of livelihood.







The Discovery Pupils Award started in 2014 and provides rewards to the elementary valedictorians and salutatorians of Brgy. Decalachao, San Jose, Maricaban, Dicabobo, and Bucatan Elementary Schools. This initiative is a simple way of rewarding students for their hard work at school through cash assistance and certificates.

Brigada Eskwela - Discovery Coron is proud to join Brigada Eskwela, volunteering to assist in repainting the school and participating in other maintenance activities such as lawn mowing.
